Make-up Requirements	Standard Stage Appropriate shade of foundation, black eyeliner, black mascara Eye Shadow: Maybelline #20 Velvet Crush (4 color palette) Blush: Covergirl #185 True Plum Lipstick: Revlon #641 Spicy Cinnamon Pearl Eyelashes: Dancers 10 and under “Quo” #801 , Dancers 11 and older “Quo” #809 (if Quo not available – Ardell #109) Eyelash Glue: “Full” adhesive
Hair Requirements	Front of hair: Part left side – near end of left eyebrow Starting from the left side, French braid towards the right side ending over the right ear. Braid should be approx. 1 ½ to 2 inches wide Pin tail end behind ear, tuck tail end into the appropriate hair style and pin. Hair Requirements	Front of hair: Part left side – near end of left eyebrow Starting from the left side, French braid towards the right side ending over the right ear.
